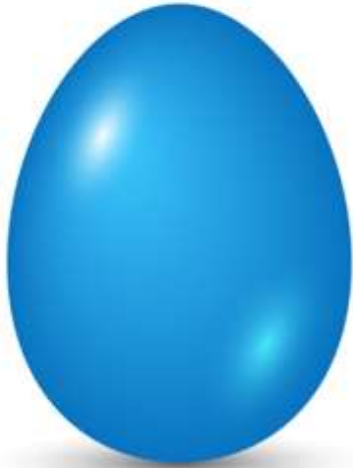

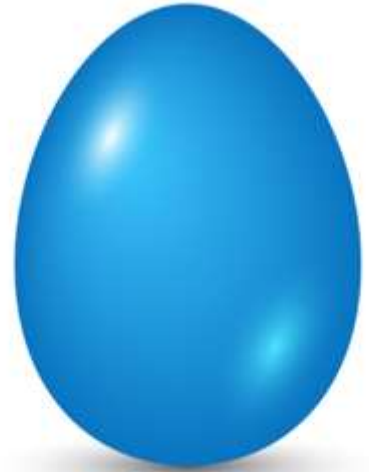

Have enclosed some photos taken at a busy Kangaroo Valley (midway between Mittagong & Nowra) over the weekend.

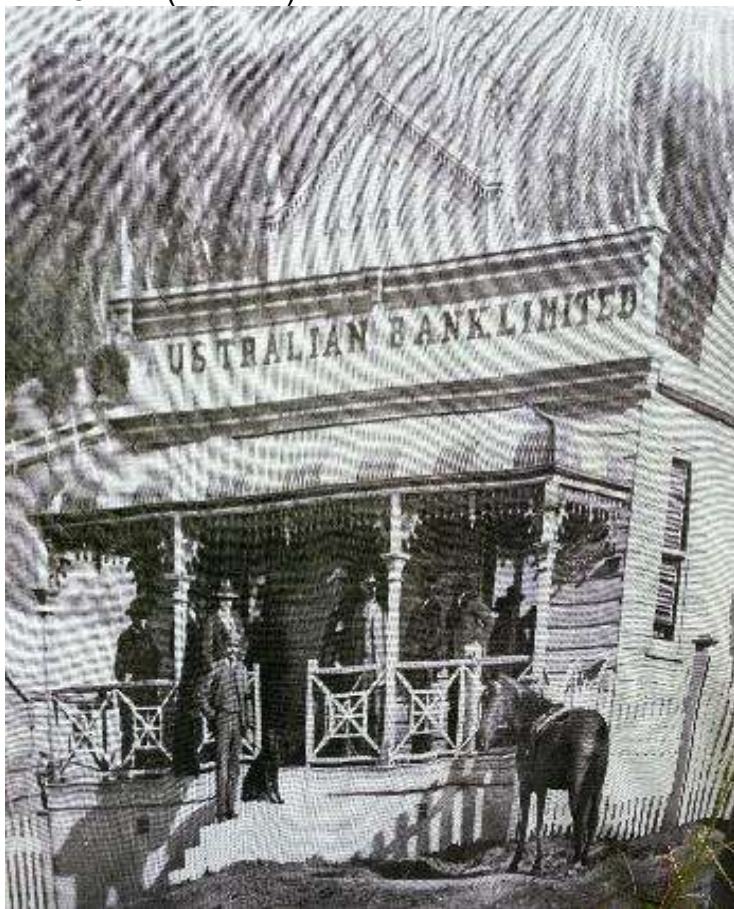
Nowra Branch conducted a weekly Agency into the 1980s.

**On Roger Fenton**

**Peter Meers wrote: -**

Graeme,

I was greatly saddened to read your email of 17<sup>th</sup> March 2024 advising the passing of Roger.

I first met Roger in 1983 in his role as NSW State Manager Corporate Banking.

He was to become a colleague, friend, and mentor.

Whilst in NSW he reported to State Managers', firstly Max Sandow and then Reg Tuxford.

Roger's earlier career had been in Victoria, including a time in Victorian Corporate Banking.

Under Roger I worked in roles as, Manager of a new electronic banking area (ANZCASH) with Alister Fotheringham, Corporate Banking Manager Administration and as a line Senior Manager. I saw Roger from several perspectives.

His tenure in this role during the 1980's saw dramatic events: -

- In 1984 ANZ acquired Grindlays Bank for A\$282million.

- The Australian Labour Government granted new banking licences to foreign banks to supposedly promote a more competitive financial market. The initiative led to an oversupply of credit in the marketplace. Corporate takeover announcements were a daily occurrence.

- The Share Market collapsed in October 1987
- ANZ's Fairfax Loan – A\$2.1 billion
- A new Australian corporate banking product – Foreign Currency Loans (mainly Swiss denominated). ANZ avoided the temptation, but you could bank on the WAILS.
- A collapse of the Australian Property Market.
- By 1992, ANZ Bank recorded its first financial loss in history – A\$579 million with bad debts of A\$1.6 billion (principally in Victoria). ANZ share price fell to A\$2.66.



These were heady times. ANZ Corporate franchise in NSW was a very profitable business as I came to know with later experience. At the time we did not have the internal accounting systems to measure profitability at a state level.

Roger was our captain and steered a steady course in NSW Corporate with a firm hand on the controls.

Around 1988/9, Roger was transferred to London, accompanied by his wife Jan.

Anton Archer had come from Grindlays Bank as Roger's successor.

I had the privilege to visit Roger in London in 1982 on a fact-finding mission to see what we could learn and transfer back to NSW Corporate Bank. Roger was working with John Ries at the time in Minerva House London on the south bank of the Thames River, near London Bridge Station. In London, Roger was responsible for ANZ

Grindlays operations in the Middle East, Africa and later Continental Europe.

In 1991 Roger returned to NSW as ANZ's State Group General Manager.

As I recall he retired from this Bank in this role.

As I said earlier, Roger was a mentor.

I still hear resonating, some of his well repeated advice.

*"Son, when you have a problem, give it to someone else"*

*"Son, do you know how much you are worth, put your hand in a bucket of water, what you can hold when you pull it out is a measure of your worth. There will always be someone ready as a replacement".*

Roger you may be gone, but not forgotten.
